

Dr. Irek Suleymanov is the International Cooperation Advisor to the JINR Director and the Head of the JINR Coordinating Group "Communication Strategy".

Dr Suleymanov holds a PhD from the Ilya-Ulyanov Ulyanovsk State Pedagogical University (for research of intercultural education's establishing in Germany) and the "Pass Economist" in Business Administration from the

Fachhochschule Köln, University Diusburg-Essen. His academic path is also based on the competencies acquired at the Freie Universität Berlin (Intercultural Education, Identity and Understanding in the Face of Cultural Diversity) and the University of Potsdam. Dr Suleymanov is participant of the MBA Program "Executive Masters in Management of Research Infrastructures", University of Milano-Bicocca.

He was previously the Head of Division for International Cooperation and Integration in Science and Technology at the Russian Ministry of Higher Education and Science, where he has enjoyed a successful career until 2020 when he joined JINR. Dr. Suleymanov has developed his practical experience in building successful communication strategies as the Representative for the Research Marketing Campaign Russia (German Federal Ministry of Education and Research) and as coordinator of number of large-scale international initiatives (e.g., the Year of Germany in Russia, Implementation of the Russian-German Roadmap on Cooperation in Education, Science, Research and Innovation etc.).
