Dear participants,

In anticipation of meeting you soon at the 28th International Scientific Conference of Young Scientists and Specialists (AYSS-2024) in Dubna, we would like to ask you to familiarize yourself with the following information.

PROGRAMME

You can find the current program on the <u>conference website</u>. Please add your presentations to your personal conference account (in the <u>My contribution</u> tab) before the start of the conference. Participants with the best reports will be awarded with memorable gifts.

Oral and poster presentations <u>must</u> be prepared in **English**. The time allocated for oral presentations is 15 minutes (including questions and discussion).

Presentations for oral reports <u>must</u> be prepared as a PDF or multimedia presentation (Microsoft PowerPoint). Please note that it will not be possible to demonstrate presentations for oral reports from participants' laptops.

Each participant in the poster section will be allocated a vertical A1 size stand (85x59 cm²) to demonstrate the report. We do not recommend using particularly dense and heavy materials for printing posters.

PARTICIPANTS PASSES TO JINR TERRITORY

Participants can receive passes to the JINR territory on Monday, October 28, from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. at the <u>JINR Visit Center</u> (5 Molodezhnaya st., Dubna).

From Tuesday to Friday, the time for receiving passes is from 8:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. at the JINR Visit Center.

Passage through the JINR checkpoint for external participants is carried out through two side gates. Wait until an employee opens the doors for you, and then pass through. In front of the window, hand **your pass and PASSPORT** to the employee for data verification, wait for the return of documents and permission to continue passing. Before passing through the frame, please put all metal and electronic items on the table to the right of the frame, press the button, wait for the green light and pass through. After passing through and the absence of a sound signal, take your belongings from the table and proceed to the exit. On Monday, October 28, from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m., members of the Organizing Committee will be at the JINR checkpoint to help you if any difficulties arise.

PARTICIPANTS REGISTRATION

Registration of participants with approved financial support for accommodation will take place on Sunday, October 27, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the lobby of their Dubna Hotel building (8 Veksler St. or 2 Moskovskaya St.). Registration of participants who will be accommodated in the University Centre dormitory will take place at the Dubna Hotel b. 1 (8 Veksler St.) at the same time.

On Monday, October 28, registration will be on the 6th floor in the Organizing Committee room next to the Conference Hall of Meshcheryakov Laboratory of Information Technologies (MLIT JINR) from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. If possible, please arrive for registration as earlier as possible, so as not to create a crowd of participants.

From Tuesday to Friday, registration will be in the Organizing Committee room from 9:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

CONFERENCE OPENING

The opening of the conference will take place in the Meshcheryakov Laboratory of Information Technologies (MLIT JINR) in the Conference Hall (5th floor) at 9:00 a.m.

REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee for participation will be 9,600 RUB (including VAT) and will cover organizational expenses, coffee breaks, participant kits, publication of papers, and the social program activities. Acceptance of payments for participants from external organizations (not JINR) is available on the conference website in the <u>Conference fee</u> tab.

EVENING PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

During the conference, <u>various cultural events</u> will be organized for participants, some of which will require registration, as the number of places is limited. Here you can take <u>a survey</u> about what events you would like to attend. You can find detailed information about the evening program activities in the attached Evening Program document.

PROCEEDINGS

All participants who provide oral presentations are encouraged to publish their materials in <u>PEPAN Letters</u>. All articles are subject to peer review.

By submitting a paper for publication in PEPAN Letters the authors imply that the material has not been published previously nor has been submitted for publication elsewhere. Authors should make a careful survey of the literature to ensure that papers do not duplicate previous work and that relevant existing knowledge has been taken into account.

Collection of the proceedings during this conference will be organized on the Indico platform. You will receive information about that and instructions later.
