The XX International Scientific Conference of Young Scientists and Specialists (AYSS-2016) will be held on 14 - 18 March 2016 and will be dedicated to the 60th anniversary of JINR.

The Conference is held annually and attended by students, PhD students, young scientists and specialists from scientific centers over the world. The Conference Proceedings with ISBN will be published. The papers recommended by the Competition Committee will be submitted for publication in PEPAN Letters.

Within the framework of the Conference, leading scientists will give lectures on the recent theoretical, experimental and applied investigations related to JINR research with emphasize on the major results obtained at JINR.

Parallel sessions:

The speakers in the parallel sessions get the stage for maximally **13 minutes** and **2 minutes** are reserved for the discussion.

Poster sessions:

Note that poster size is 83 cm width x 117 cm height (format A0).

COMPETITION OF YOUNG RESEARCHERS' WORKS

JINR AYSS Prize competition will be held for young scientists and specialists up to 35 years who make oral presentations at the Conference (poster presentations are not eligible for the competition). Talks will be presented in 24 blocks of parallel sessions. From each block, the best presentation will be selected for participation in the Competition and all selected participants will present their shortened version of talks (10 minutes including discussion) during plenary session on 17th March 2016. The Committee will select 12 best presentations who will be awarded with cash prize. To participate in the Competition you have to mark a special field in registration form which is open for modification. Your decision will be taken into account not later than 1 hour before the beginning of each block.

SOCIAL PROGRAMME

We would like to welcome all the participants at Conference banquet which will take place at the International Conference Hall (Stroiteley street, 2) on Thursday evening. We will provide a variety of sport activities.

PROCEEDINGS

The Conference Proceedings are planned to be published in electronic form soon after the Conference. The Proceedings will include manuscripts of all talks at the Conference. The detailed information on the preparation of the paper will be given in April. Instructions for preparation will be provided at the conference website. The deadline for paper submission is 1st May 2016. Presenters who will be selected for participation in JINR AYSS Prize Competition will obtain possibility to submit their paper for publication in peer-reviewed journal PEPAN Letters. The maximal length of paper is restricted up to 8 pages and the template is available at the journal website.

TRAVEL

The Conference will be held at the Joint Institute for Nuclear Research in Dubna. Schematic map of Dubna is available at the Conference website (Venue). If you arrive by train or travel from the airport on your own, be aware of the following information.

How to reach Moscow from airports:

from Sheremetyevo airport

The timetable of direct trains from Sheremetyevo airport to Moscow is available <u>here</u>. The travel time to Belorusskiy railway station is 30 minutes. The ticket costs 450 rubles. Then it is recommended to get underground and reach station Savelovskaya.

Transfer from the Sheremetyevo airport to Dubna will be provided by organizers.

from **Domodedovo airport**

The timetable of direct trains from Domodedovo airport to Moscow is available <u>here</u>. The travel time is 40-50 minutes. The ticket costs 450 rubles. The trains arrive at Paveletsky railway station from where you can continue by underground to Savelovskaya underground station.

Transfer from the Domodedovo airport to Dubna will be provided by organizers.

From **Vnukovo airport**

The timetable of direct trains from Vnukovo airport to Moscow is available here.

The travel time is 35 minutes. The ticket costs 450 rubles. The trains arrive at Kievsky railway station from where you can continue by underground to Savelovskaya underground station.

Transfer from the Sheremetyevo airport to Dubna will NOT be provided by organizers.

How to reach Dubna from Moscow:

The buses Moscow-Dubna depart from Savelovsky railway station at 08.15, 11.30, 13.30, 14.30, 15.30, 16.20, 17.25, 18.00, 20.00, 23.00.

The buses Dubna-Moscow depart from Bolshaya Volga railway station at 06.15, 06.45, 07.45, 09.15, 10.45, 12.15, 13.15, 16.15, 17.00, 18.45

The trains to Dubna depart from Savelovsky railway station (underground station Savelovskaya).

How to reach hotels:

If you arrive to Dubna by your own, it is strongly recommended to take a taxi from the railway station to your hotel. The average price of taxi should not exceed 90 rubles (approximately 1 USD).

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is reserved in the Dubna Hotel 1 or in the Dubna Hotel 2 by the Organizing committee according to your request in the registration form. The breakfast is included.

ENTRY PERMISSION AND SOME ADDITIONAL RULES

To enter the territory of the Institute you will need to provide your passport at the entrance.

Laptops can be taken in and out of the territory of the institute without special permission. A beamer & PC will be available to allow for Powerpoint or similar presentations.

Attention! Participants are not allowed to take cameras to the territory of the Institute. Note as well that **taking photos** inside the territory of the Institute **is strongly forbidden**.
