

Information on the progress of the activity of the Working Subgroup on Radiobiology and Astrobiology for the preparation of JINR's strategic long-range plan.

International working Group for Strategic Long-Range Plan (SLRP) for JINR has been established 2017 aiming at elaboration of the SLRP as highest priority for the future development of JINR.

The laboratories organized thematic sub-groups attracting the experts from the JINR laboratories and best representatives of the global research community. By development of the SLRP the research interest and requests from the member states as well as development and trends of international research landscape have been respected and taken into account. Extensive discussions took place in order to formulate the vision of SLRP for the topics represented in particular lab.

SLRP will represent the outcome of detailed scrutiny by international leading experts and will help to focus the views of the scientific community on the most promising branches of the research fields of JINR and to create the basis for funding agencies to provide adequate support.

Currently the sub-group on Radiation Biology and Astrobiology is in process of finalizing the executive summary to be presented to the Joint Scientific Council of JINR. The whole work on SLRP is planned to complete by the end of 2019.

Status of activities on preparation of the final document on radiation biology is presented.
